Cabernet Sauvignon

Consentino The Cab California (2017)

10/ 37

Dark cherry and ripe plum with a hint of vanilla and cocoa. An approachable structure with a balanced and long finish.

Christopher Michael Washington (2016)

13/ 50

Bursting with blue and black fruits that are framed by sweet vanilla and cocoa from the oak in which it was aged.

Pinot Noir

Underwood Oregon (2017)

9/ 34

The light strawberry fruit carries herbal and bitter green flavors, yet everything is in proper proportion.

Storypoint Sonoma County, Ca (2016)

10/37

A very deep color and concentrated blackberry flavors give this full-bodied wine a big impact. Berry compote and light touches of maple and wood smoke waft from the glass, then deep dark fruit flavors coat the palate.

Malbec

El Portillo Malbec Salentein, Argentina (2017)

10/ 37

Fresh flavors of redcurrant and sweet black cherry, tannins finishing with notes of cinnamon and cloves.

Merlot

Angeline Reserve, Paso Robles, CA (2016)

10/ 37

This wine opens with fresh blackberry, notes of elderberry and plum, making way for black cherry on the midpalate.

Red Wine

The Cleaver California (Vintage 2015)

10/ 37

Flavors of blackberry and tobacco leaves dipped in cherry sauce are integrated in this incredibly silky drink.

Seven Falls Paterson, WA (2015)

9/ 34

Mix of dark fruit and softer red fruit. Hints of dried fruit and anise. Mouth-coating with a spicy, smooth, elegant finish.

Barossa Valley Estate GSM Barossa Valley, Australia (2016)

8/28

Fragrant violet with a burst of red berryfruits, lingering softly on a velvety texture.

Shiraz/Syrah

Snoqualmie Columbia Valley (2016)

9/ 34

The wine is layered with rich blackberry, dark cherries and hints of dark, creamy chocolate ganache.

Chianti

Chianti Caposaldo, Italy (2016)

11/40

Smooth, perfumed red fruit aromas lead to a red, berry and cherry palate with lovely structure and an elegant finish.

Zinfandel

Terra d'Oro Amador Co., California (2015)

10/ 37

With aromas of rich, spicy clove and fig, generous fruit with hints of vanilla in the nose. Flavors of plums and blackberries with a round mouthfeel of tannins on the finish.

Sweet Red

Adesso Civitella Di Romagna, Italy (2017)

10/ 37

Pleasantly sweet, Adesso's berry aromas and flavors are impossible to resist. Low in alcohol, Adesso is a fun and easy to drink red wine for those who prefer their wines "off dry".

Porto

Dow's Late Vintage Portugal (2011)

10/ -

On the nose very intense, brimming with concentrated aromas of ripe fruits such as cassis, combined with rockrose and peppery spice. On the palate, very powerful and full-bodied, fresh and well structured, packed with flavors of black berries and hints of chocolate with a long and slightly dry finish. (3oz serving)

RL Buller & Son's Victoria, Australia

10/ -

The Victoria Tawny exhibits a medium garnet color in addition to sweet, unctuous strawberry and cherry fruit. It is a blend of four grapes: Carina, Cabernet Sauvignon, Grenache and Shiraz. (3oz serving)

White Wine

Chardonnay

Bread & Butter California (2016) 10/ 37
The creamy custard notes are balanced by a soft minerality and hints of worn leather.

Silver Monterey Co., Ca (2016) 11/ 40
This wine sees no wood, to maintain the bright fruit characters produced in the Mer Soleil Vineyard.

Mer Soleil Reserve Monterey Co., Ca (2016) - / 42
White peach comes through on the palate, which has a vibrant acidity balanced by the natural character of fully ripe fruit. Medium to full-bodied, this wine has a finish that is lengthy but never heavy.

Sauvignon Blanc & Chenin Blanc

Better Half Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand (2017) 9/ 34
Vibrant and zesty fruit aromas of peach, nectarine and passion fruit along with an intriguing hint of thyme.

Emmolo Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley, CA (2016) 10/37
this wine is more minerality-driven than fruit-driven. Not grassy or overly ripe, with fruit flavors and mineral notes.

Dry Creek Chenin Blanc, Sonoma Co., California (2017) 9/ 34
Honeydew melon, white peach spring forward with notes of orange blossom, honeysuckle and chamomile.

Pinot Grigio

Benvolio Italy (2017) 7/ 26
As Pinot Grigio in Italy, the style is lighter, charming and fruit driven. Pairs with rich foods like pork, and charcuterie.

Riesling

Château St. Michelle Columbia Valley (2016) 8/ 30
Dry, refreshing style of Riesling with beautiful fruit flavors, crisp acidity and an elegant finish.

Anew Washington (2017) 8/ 30
Anew Riesling offers an inviting balance of pure fruit flavor, expressive aromas and crisp acidity.

Rosé

Conundrum California (2015 Vintage) 10/ 37
There are floral tones to the fruit core of this wine, with hints of white cherry, melon rind and strawberry hull.

Aïme Roquesante Rose Cotes De Provence, France (2017) 9/ 34
Aromas of sweet berries in the nose. The palate offers lots of freshness and excellent balance. Lovely watermelon and grapefruit aromas contribute to freshness for a delicious finish.

Sparkling

Roscato Rosso Dolce, Italy (2016) 8/ 28
A blush wine produced in the Moscato d'Asti style, with residual sugars giving it an off-dry finish.

Opera Prima Moscato, Spain (2017) 7/ 26
Delicate bubbles caress the palate offering a silky and pleasant sweetness balanced by a crisp, refreshing finish.

Benvolio Prosecco Italy (2017) 7/ 26
The crisp acidity acts as a counterpoint to the flavors of ripe citrus, fresh peaches, lemon, green apples and grapefruit.

Tapas Cellar

- Cuvee Mailys Red Wine***, Domaine Juliette Avril Cairanne, France (2014) **40**
Beautiful dark garnet color with purple highlights; the initial nose is hints of red fruit, blackcurrant and blueberry.
- La Crema Pinot Noir***, Sonoma Coast. Ca (2016) **42**
On the nose red cherry, plum, pomegranate and sweet tobacco. On the palate, multi-layered red, blue and black berry fruit, plums and cherries, and a hint of blood orange underpin subtle layers of exotic spice and toast. Fine tannins and balanced acidity drives along finish.
- Decoy Cabernet***, Sonoma County, Ca (2016) **60**
This wine is ripe, soft, and easy on the palate. Its aromas and flavors of red currants and some earth notes make it an excellent dinner wine.
- Stags Leap Cabernet***, Napa Valley, Ca (2015) **90**
opens with inviting aromas of dark cherry and berry fruit, cassis, sweet vanilla and a hint of olive. The palate has a rich mouthfeel and aftertaste of black cherry and dusty cocoa.
- Duckhorn Cabernet***, Napa Valley, Ca (2015) **120**
With a nose of boysenberry, cherry, strawberry, cedar, sage, and licorice. The palate's fruit flavors are underscored by bright acidity, firm tannins, and notes of fig, and cinnamon.
- Bull By The Horns Cabernet***, Paso Robles, CA (2016) **42**
This blend of 85% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% Syrah features aromas of black currant, cedar, crème de menthe, and chocolate truffle. Black cherry and Loganberry jam with a graham cracker crust on the palate. Juicy tannins with a balanced finish.
- Chateauneuf-Du-Pape Red Wine***, Domaine Juliette Avril, France (2014) **65**
There is a restrained air of raspberry, with a brief sweetness in it, on the nose. The palate delivers tasty berry fruit and a good stretch of lifted tannin, adding licorice to the final moments.
- Aviary Red***, Napa Valley, CA (2010) **70**
Much like an aviary, the blend of different grape varieties, terroirs, and vineyards interact and harmonize in each blend to create wines that are beautiful, enjoyable, and captivating. Each component of our wines are wonderful, but together, they combine into a truly great experience.
- BV Rutherford Cabernet***, Napa Valley, Ca (2015) **80**
A beautiful and silky Napa cabernet that shows mint and berry character with hints of currants. Medium- to full-bodied, juicy and delicious. Vivid finish.
- BV Tapestry Reserve Red***, Napa Valley, Ca (2014) **130**
Complex aromas of blackcurrants, tobacco and stones. Medium to full body, very fine tannins and a polished, refined, textured finish. A wine that harkens back to its traditions.
